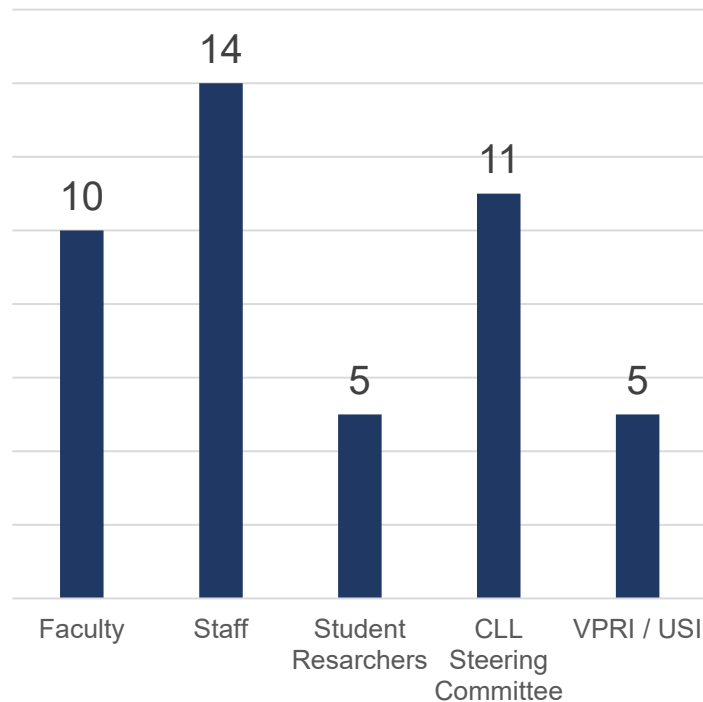
## LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

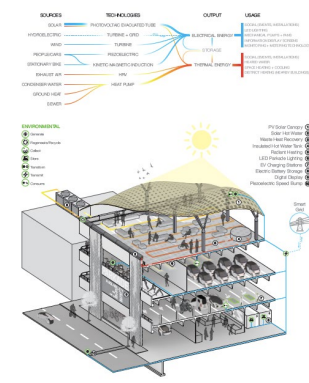
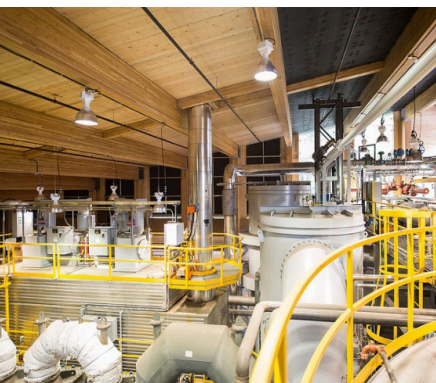
