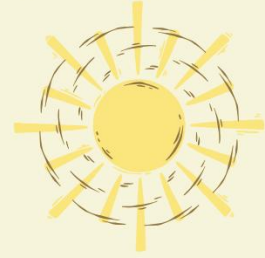


2024/25 Youth Climate Ambassador's Project (YCAP)

Who we worked with

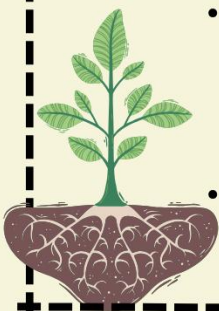
Throughout the year, the YCAP cohort relied on a number of friends:

Between October and April the YCAP Cohort:

- Delivered 15 workshops
- Visited 9 schools
- Engaged 300 students
- Developed 2 new workshops
- Trained 10 UBC student volunteers
